NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Plan Commission of the Village of Brownsville, Dodge County, is scheduled to hold a public hearing at the Brownsville Community Center, 871 Main St., Brownsville Wisconsin, on October 13, 2021 to receive comments and input regarding a proposed Conditional Use Permit to the Village of Brownsville, 871 Main St., Brownsville WI, to allow for a public park on lot 10/718 Evergreen Dr. of the Pine Hill Subdivision as required per Village of Brownsville Zoning Code 18.02(7)3.

The Village Board and Plan Commission meetings begins at 6:00 p.m. This public hearing is scheduled to take place immediately following Plan Commission recommendation of acceptance of the parcel donation from Michels Investments LLP, and Village of Brownsville Board action of donation. This hearing shall be public and citizens and interested persons shall then be heard. Following the public hearing the Plan Commission will vote on whether to issue the conditional use permit.
