

VILLAGE OF BROWNSVILLE FIREWORKS REGULATIONS

The Brownsville Police Department wishes Village residents a safe and happy July 4th Holiday Celebration.

Village ordinance 9.36(7) adopts State Statute 167.10 which regulates the possession and use of fireworks. The items listed below are lawful for use in the Village.

Allowed fireworks items include the following items:

- Snakes.
- Sparklers not exceeding 36 inches in length.
- A device designed to spray out paper confetti or streamers and which contains less than one-quarter grain of explosive mixture.
- A smoke producing device that is designed primarily to burn pyrotechnic smoke-producing mixtures, at a controlled rate, and that produces audible or visible effects, or audible and visible effects.
- A cylindrical fountain that consists of one or more tubes and that is classified by the federal department of transportation as a Division 1.4 explosive.
- A cone fountain that shoots smoke and or sparks into the air.
- A novelty device that spins or moves on the ground.
- Noise makers that are a fuseless device that is designed to produce audible or visible effects or audible and visible effects, and that contains less than one-quarter grain of explosive mixture.

Fire crackers, bottle rockets, missiles and rockets, cones that shoot projectiles or exploding balls into the air, aerial mortars and similar devices are prohibited.

With the dry conditions increasing the fire danger please use extra care when using allowed fireworks devices.
